The **Data Controller**, IAERE, Corso Magenta 63, 20123 Milan, e-mail: iaere@iaere.org is informing you in regard to the processing of your data.

1) Legal purpose and basis for processing, mandatory release of the data requested and consequences

The processing of your personal data in our possession, or that will be requested from you, or that will be communicated to us, is and shall be carried out for the following purposes:

- a) Participation to IAERE 10th Anniversary Young Scholars' Awards

2) Categories of data processed

Personal data, contact information (including electronic), images.

3) Sources of personal data

The data are collected from the Data Subject.

4) Recipients/categories of recipients of personal data

For the abovementioned purposes, the data controller will communicate certain data:

- i. to those authorised by the Data Controller (employees and collaborators involved in the organisation and management of the event, the related audio/video footage and subsequent dissemination on the Data Controller's media);
- ii. to other companies and professionals involved in business processes, such as: law firms, consultants and professionals employed for the correct execution of contractual obligations or to enforce any rights, interests, or claims arising from the contract, to companies that maintain and operate information systems, to companies participating in the organisation of the event, its related audio/video recording, editing and dissemination, to those responsible for the managing and maintaining websites and social media channels on behalf of the Data Controller, and to postal services;
- iii. to state administrations, public and private bodies, also following inspections and verifications;
- iv. to individuals who may access your data by virtue of legal provisions or secondary or EU legislation.

Only the category of recipients is indicated as this is subject to frequent updates and revisions. For this reason, you can request the updated list of recipients by contacting the Data Controller at the email address indicated above.

The Data Controller guarantees the utmost care, ensuring that the communication of your personal data to the aforementioned recipients involves only the data necessary to achieve the specific purposes for which it is intended.

5) Period of retention of personal data or, if this is not possible, the criteria used to determine that period

Your data will be kept for the time necessary to carry out the organisational and execution activities related to the management of the award.

If selected for the award, your personal data and image will be kept for as long as the online pages related to the award is maintained.

The data necessary for the forwarding of communications concerning new events held by the Data Controller will be processed until your consent is withdrawn.

In any case, all data whose processing is necessary in connection with legal obligations will be retained for the legal duration.

6) Rights of the Data Subject

The data subject has the right to:

to file a complaint, pursuant to Article 77 of GDPR, with the national supervisory authority of the member state of the European Union where you are habitually resident or the place of work or where the alleged violation of the right has occurred; In the event that this State is Italy, the subject whom you can contact is the Italian Data Protection Authority.

To exercise your rights, please contact the Data Controller at the contact details above.

Furthermore, the data subject may exercise, at any time and free of charge, the following rights against the controller in accordance with EU Regulation 2016/679, if the circumstances so require: Right of access (Art. 15); Right to rectification (Art. 16); Right to deletion (Art. 17); Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18); Right to data portability (Art. 19); Right to objection (Art. 21)
